From Seattle travel south on Interstate 5 and take exit 77. Turn right on Highway 6. Immediately, at the next intersection, Riverside Drive, turn left. The museum is on the left-hand side approximately 1/4 mile from Highway 6.

From Portland travel north on Interstate 5 and take exit 77. Turn left on Highway 6 and cross over the Interstate. Turn left on Riverside Drive. The museum is on the left-hand side approximately 1/4 mile from Highway 6.
